
### CHRISTMAS MEANS FAMILY BOARD GAMES

An unusual early 19th century antique white wood game, with painted black line decoration to the top, rim and written on the board "The new military game of German tactics' pink lining paper to the underneath. The game is played similar to Fox and Geese but has two red foxes and 20 white hens (with two spare). A game of inequality!

### SHOW YOUR LOVE AT CHRISTMAS

A large and dramatic pavé set diamond pendant on an 18ct white gold chain; the brilliant cut diamonds weigh 6.72cts and are a dazzling white colour, full of fire. The bale opens and closes on a hinge so the pendant can be worn on a gold chain or a pearl necklace. Weight of heart 17.2gms; weight of chain 18.1gms. Diameter of heart 3.5cm x 3.5cm and including the bale 4.5cm. The back of the pendant is in a honeycomb pattern. The chain is 45cm long and 0.35cm wide and is fitted with a strong lobster claw clasp which has a cabochon sapphire press down button. The pendant and chain are both hallmarked 18ct gold and the chain is stamped 750

## JEWELLERY GIFT FOR CHRISTMAS

A superb ruby, diamond and doid Constellation Bangle, dated 1958.
